

## Who can play 3v3 Soccer?

3v3 Soccer is a weekend soccer festival open to players of **ALL AGES** and skill levels. The divisions are set up as follows: 5-19 year olds (Competitive and Recreational), COED (Must be over 18), Adult (Must be over 18).

## How do I determine which age bracket is appropriate for my team?

The age divisions/age requirements are as follows (each division listed has separate divisions for Male and Female, youth U5-U19 also have separate divisions for Competitive and Recreational). Teams will be registered into the division of the oldest, most experienced player on the team, even if players span more than one age group. YOUTH COED teams must sign up for the appropriate age and competitive level in the MALE division.

## How do I register for the tournament?

Simply register by downloading the registration form at [www.acyso.org](http://www.acyso.org), fill out the entry form and return it to the address listed below. Full payment must be received and the registration form must be received, in order for your entire registration process to be complete. Entry forms are accepted via regular mail, do not send first class or where a signature is required to receive it.

In order to complete the registration process, please be sure that you have submitted the following documentation:

- Completed registration form with payment (one check, MO or cash)

- Medical Releases will be viewed at Tournament Check-In

## **What do we receive if we win? What are we competing for?**

Besides bragging rights, each participant (if registered by the deadline) will receive a t-shirt and all 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams will receive a trophy. All U5 through U8 teams will receive a Participation Trophy.

## **How many players can I have on the roster?**

You may carry a maximum of 6 players with a minimum of 3 players. Your team's entry fee is the same regardless of the number of players on team.

## **Who needs to come to pre-event check-in?**

One member and/or coach from each team must attend the tournament check-in at the field at least one hour prior to your first game to pick up the teams schedule, tournament rules, and event t-shirts. Coach must also present proof of age and medical releases for each player at check-in.

## **Can I call to check in and receive my team's schedule?**

We're sorry, but we can't allow teams to call in to check-in. Brackets will be posted online by Thursday evening prior to the tournament (First game times will not change). Preliminary Schedules may be posted earlier, but the official schedule will be posted on Thursday evening.

## **What do I need to bring to check-in?**

A valid Player Pass from a US Soccer Affiliate, Birth Certificate or Drivers License for each player, as well as a medical release for all youth players.

## **How are the divisions broken up?**

Teams will be placed into divisions based upon age, gender and playing experience. Any team or player determined by the Tournament's Event Director to have falsified age or skill level will be dismissed from the tournament. Teams that span more than one age group will be placed into the division of the oldest, most experienced player on the team. The tournament administration will make every effort to place teams into divisions with similar players.

## **What are the rules for the Tournament?**

## Does each player need a player card?

No **BUT** all participants **MUST CARRY PROOF OF AGE AT ALL TIMES**.

## Are numbers on jerseys required?

No, but all players must wear similar team shirts (same color) during play, and each team must bring both a light and dark colored shirt. If both teams are wearing the same color, the home team (listed first on the schedule) must change to their alternate shirt/jersey.

## Can I request a specific time to play?

Unfortunately, we can't guarantee to be able to accommodate this type of request.

## Can I change my roster after I am registered?

Yes, you can adjust your roster until the start of tournament play. You may turn in roster changes at the Headquarters Tent at the event (before your first game).

## How do I know if my team should play in the recreational or competitive division?

Teams that have at least one player with competitive experience will be classified as a competitive team. Example: If you have one player with competitive experience you will be placed in the competitive bracket. Generally competitive teams or players play, practice or train 2-3 days or more per week. All other teams and players will be classified as recreational unless the team decides to play at the competitive level.
